Nā Lei Hulu i ka Wēkiu (NLH), a tax exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, is conducting this raffle to raise funds for ongoing programs and productions, and pursuant to California Penal Code Section 320.5, et seq.

Q: How do I purchase raffle tickets?

Anyone who is 18 years of age or older and a U.S. resident can purchase a \$5 raffle ticket from Nā Lei Hulu haumana (students), board members, and raffle team members now thru July 16, 2026. Raffle tickets will also be available during our July 31, August 1 & 2, 2026 shows at the Presidio Theatre.

Q: What are the raffle ticket purchase, entry and prize drawing dates?

Raffle ticket sales begin MAY 12, 2026 and end on AUG 2, 2026 at 2:00pm -- raffle ticket stubs must be deposited into raffle drum by 2:00pm on AUG 2, 2026. If all tickets are sold before the AUG 2, 2026 deadline, raffle ticket sales will end sooner. **Drawing will be held on AUG 2, 2026 at 2:45pm** during our performance at Presidio Theatre, 99 Moraga Avenue, San Francisco. *Need not be present to win.*

Q: How do I redeem my prize?

Prize winners will be notified at the contact information provided on the raffle ticket stub. In addition, a list of winning ticket numbers will be posted on the Nā Lei Hulu raffle website within a week of the drawing.

Q: Is a raffle ticket purchase tax-deductible?

No. The IRS does not consider the purchase of raffle tickets to be a tax-deductible contribution. The IRS has taken the position that amounts paid for chances in raffles, lotteries or similar drawings for valuable prizes are not gifts and consequently do not qualify as deductible charitable contributions. Q: Are raffle prizes considered income?

Yes. The Grand Prize Winner and winners of prizes valued over \$2,000 assume all fees, local, state and federal taxes and are required to submit the appropriate IRS forms in order to be awarded the prize.
